

Welcome to carSHAIr! Below is a detailed overview of our safety procedures and mandatory rules for operating our E-bikes. Please read them carefully and if at any point you have questions, please reach out to our concierge team to further assist you. E - bikes can be rented out during the hours of 8 am to 6-8 pm (depending upon location). We offer hourly, daily, and weekly rates for customers who are wanting to rent our E-bikes!

1. BIKE LIABILITY

You (the renter) will be personally liable for any damage that occurs during the rental period. If any damage were to occur, you would be given an invoice with a detailed breakdown specifying the areas of the E-Bike that need repairs. You (the renter) will also be liable for the bicycle if it were stolen or any other accessories that come with the bike were to be stolen. Helmet, phone mount, basket, etc. Any damage that occurs to personal belongings during a rental period you , the renter, will also be liable and responsible for.

The amounts are as follows:

Bike helmet: \$80

Bike: \$3,700

Phone Mount: \$20

Invoice will be given dependent on damage that occurs during a rental period.

2. SAFETY RULES

Go With the Traffic Flow.

Ride on the right in the same direction as other vehicles. Go with the flow – not against it.

Obey All Traffic Laws.

A bicycle is a vehicle and you're a driver. When you ride in the street, obey all traffic signs, signals, and lane markings.

Yield to Traffic When Appropriate.

Almost always, drivers on a smaller road must yield (wait) for traffic on a major or larger road. If there is no stop sign or traffic signal and you are coming from a smaller roadway (out of a driveway, from a sidewalk, a bike path, etc.), you must slow down and look to see if the way is clear before proceeding. This also means yielding to pedestrians who have already entered a crosswalk.

Be Predictable.

Ride in a straight line, not in and out of cars. Signal your moves to others.

Stay Alert at All Times.

Use your eyes AND ears. Watch out for potholes, cracks, wet leaves, storm grates, railroad tracks, or anything that could make you lose control of your bike. You need your ears to hear traffic and avoid dangerous situations; don't wear a headset when you ride.

Look Before Turning.

When turning left or right, always look behind you for a break in traffic, then signal before making the turn. Watch for left- or right-turning traffic.

Watch for Parked Cars.

Ride far enough out from the curb to avoid the unexpected from parked cars (like doors opening, or cars pulling out).

3. REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 18 years of age or older to rent a bike.
- 17 years of age or younger must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Participants must agree to sign the release form and signup via the carSHAIr app prior to rental.
- A valid state driver's license, state ID card, or passport of the person who rents the bike (and signs the rental contract) must be left as a deposit.
- All renters are required to wear a helmet when riding a bike. Helmets are provided at no additional cost but if damaged or stolen a fee of \$80 will be issued.
- Damaged rental equipment:
The Renter will be charged for damages that occur during the rental period as seen under bike liability section.
- eBikes are not allowed to be ridden in the sand on the beach.
- eBikes must be stored indoors overnight.
- No refunds for any reason.

4. RENTAL RETURN

You must notify the attendant of the bike return at the rental location. You will be personally liable for loss or damage should you fail to do so. Please return all bikes by 6 - 8pm (dependent upon location) or the following day if you choose to rent the bike for an extended period of time.

5. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

Before using the bike, inspect for loose, frayed, or worn parts. If in doubt, do not rent the bike and report back to the attendant.

6. RELEASE

I understand that my use of a bike has been arranged by carSHAIr as a convenience to me. I further understand and agree that carSHAIr does not accept any responsibility or liability for my safety during the period I use the bike; therefore, I release and hold harmless carSHAIr, and its members, their owners, officers, directors, agents and employees from against any actions, costs, claims, losses, expenses and/or damages, including attorney's fees, arising out of or resulting from my use of the e-bike.

Releaser understands and for valuable consideration hereby expressly waives all of the rights and benefits of Section 1542 of the California Civil Code which reads as follows:

A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him must have materially affected the settlement with the debtor.
